HOME FOR THE HOLLYWOOD LAND & WATER
COMPANY, THE TOGGERY SHOP MEN'S WEAR
WAS ON THE GROUND FLOOR, EAST SIDE. IN
1934 JAMES BEEDING CONVERTED THE
BUILDING INTO A DRUG STORE. IN 1964
ARON & ZARIANA HALPERN RESTORED THE
BUILDING'S 1925 SPLENDOR.
