## Historic Preservation Grant Initiative

The Hollywood Historical Society (“HHS”) is offering modest grants to homeowners for the preservation, protection, and/or restoration of historic elements of the homeowners' historic residence. In 2024, up to \$75,000 will be awarded to Hollywood homeowners, with a maximum of \$15,000 to any individual owner. Grant applicants must be members in good standing of the HHS. Grants will be project based. HHS grant committee members and their families are not eligible.

### Grant Eligibility:

- The structure must be at least 50 years old.
- The structure must be within Hollywood city limits.
- Grants may be used for exterior or interior projects which preserve the historical structure and nature of the design.
- Your acceptance of any grant awards will include permission to use “before and after” photos of your project for HHS promotions. Your name and address will not be shared without your express permission. “Before” photos are required for consideration. If the grant is awarded, the grant recipient must also provide “after” photos upon completion of the project.
- Contractor and/or material cost estimates will be required.
- If there are code violations on your structure, please include these in the grant application.
- The applicant is responsible for any building permits required by the City.
- Please submit a copy of the Certificate of Appropriateness (COA), if applicable.
